UPDATES/NEWS:

2020-21 NFHS Spirit Safety Rules and AACCA Rules for Cheerleading will now be the same.

2021 State Cheer Competition will be on Saturday, March 6, 2021.

NFHS has published their phases for how sports/activities should go back. As you might imagine, competitive cheer is in the last phase to go back. Sideline cheerleading is in the first phase because that should not involve any direct contact with each other.

The CAS score sheet committee decided **not to do** a complete score sheet revision. There have been some minor changes that have been made because of NFHS safety rules changes.

Many leagues for Cheer have rules and regulations based on NFHS and CIAC for Cheer. CAS Representative Chere Miller will be trying to have a share folder on CAS/CIAC website of recommendations for Cheer from other Leagues and schools.

Some leagues are allowing stunting ONLY 5 in a Stunt group week of September 21, 2020; again depends on your school and League – Communication with your AD and League is IMPORTANT
